**PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 163 OF BHARATIYA NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA (BNSS):**  
**No. UMG-6/MISC/2023/29** : In view of the instructions set forth by the Assam State Election Commission and for peaceful conduct of the General Election to Bodoland Teritorial Council, 2025, I, Sri Pulak Patgiri, ACS, District Magistrate, Udalguri District, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 of BNSS, do hereby promulgate this prohibitory order on the following activities throughout Udalguri District with immediate effect:

1. Obstruction/procession in front of polling booths or any places of public importance by forming an assembly of 05 (five) or more persons and/or indulging in any other activity which may disturb peace and tranquility,
2. Carrying fire arms/weapons or explosive substances of any nature which may cause injury or threat to any other people,
3. Use and throwing of fire crackers in the public places/roads/bus stations/railway stations etc. which may cause breach of peace and tranquility among the public,
4. Holding of public meeting/rallies/procession/dharna in any public place without permission,
5. Inflammatory speeches, communal or anti-state / anti-national speeches / banner / poster / wall writing etc.,
6. Use of loud speaker, microphones etc. without permission,
7. In addition, no person shall commit any of the following acts within a polling station or in any public or private place within a distance of 100 meters of Polling Stations on poll day namely:
  - a. Canvassing for votes after closure of campaign period,
  - b. Display of campaign related posters or banners,
  - c. Persuading any elector not to vote for a particular candidate,
  - d. Persuading any elector not to vote at the election,
  - e. Using or operating any apparatus for amplifying or reproducing the human voice, such as megaphone or a loudspeaker within 100 meters of Polling Station on the day of poll,
  - f. Shouting or otherwise acting in a disorderly manner on the day of poll,
  - g. Use of loudspeaker during the period of 48 hours ending with the poll closing time.
8. Additionally, with regard to the international border with Bhutan, near Bhairabkunda, the movement of both unauthorized people and vehicles, for exit to Bhutan and entry to Indian Territory from Bhutan is to be restrained, as a measure to reduce the risk of potential disruption of the polling process. However, the below mentioned exemptions are being allowed for restricted period of P-3 days i.e. 5:00 PM on 19/09/2025 till the end of poll on 26/09/2025:
  1. Medical emergency cases to travel from Bhutan to India,
  2. Indian Citizen or foreign tourists who are already on tour or otherwise in Bhutan to be allowed, on producing valid travel documents to competent authorities as per due process,
  3. All tourists willing to travel to Bhutan to be allowed, on producing valid travel documents to competent authorities as per due process, and
  4. Movement of essential goods (perishable, etc.) vehicles to be allowed after thorough checks, at border check posts by competent authority.
  5. Any voter under No.31-Khwirwbari (ST), 32-Bhergaon (ST), 33-Nonoi Serfang (Non-ST), 34-Khalingduar (ST), 35-Mwdwibari (Open), 36-Horisinga (ST), 37-Dwhwnsri (ST), 38-Bhairabkunda (ST), 39-Pasnwi Serfang (Non-ST) and 40-Rowta (ST) may be allowed to enter to cast their votes subject to verification by competent authority.

Due to exigency of situation, this order is passed ex-parte.


Exceptions:

:: Point No. 1 will not be applicable in case of the voter intending to vote in the polling booths.

:: Point No. 2 will not be applicable in case of police/paramilitary/military personnel.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force until further orders. Any violation of the order will result in prosecution as per provisions of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS). Given under my hand and seal on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2025.
