PROHIBITORY ORDER
(U/S of 163 BNSS)

PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 163 OF BHARATIYA NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA (BNSS) No.UDL/GELA/2026/10 : WHEAREAS, in view of the smooth conduct of the General Election to Assam Legislative Assembly, 2026 that immediate measures are necessary;

Hence, being so satisfied and in the public interest, I, **Sri Jay Vikas, IAS, District Magistrate, Udalguri**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me **under Section 163 of BNSS**, do hereby promulgate this prohibitory order on the following activities throughout the Udalguri District with immediate effect:

- 1) Holding of any public meeting/rallies/procession or unlawful assemblies is hereby prohibited from **5.00 PM of 7th April, 2026 till completion of poll.**
- 2) No assembly of **05 (five) or more persons** shall be allowed in any public place during the aforesaid period.
- 3) No loudspeaker shall be permitted to be used during **the period of 48 hours ending with the time of closing of poll.**
- 4) **Restriction on presence of political functionaries and campaign functioning who belongs to other constituency after the campaign period is over.**
- 5) Restrictions on any inflammatory speeches, communal or anti-state speeches / anti-national speeches / banner poster / wall writing etc.
- 6) Entry prohibited into 200 mtr radius of Polling Stations by private vehicles used by owners either for themselves or for member of their own families for going to polling vote to exercise their franchise.
- 7) No person shall commit any of the following acts within a polling station or in any public or private place within a distance of 100 meters of Polling Stations on poll day namely:
 - a) Canvassing for votes after closure of campaign period,
 - b) Display of campaign related posters or banners,
 - c) Persuading any elector not to vote for a particular candidate,
 - d) Persuading any elector not to vote at the election,
 - e) Using or operating any apparatus for amplifying or reproducing the human voice, such as megaphone or a loudspeaker within 100 meters of Polling Station on the day of poll,
 - f) Shouting or otherwise acting in a disorderly manner on the day of poll.

The order shall not apply in respect of police and army personnel and on duty Magistrates, Judicial officers and persons engaged on govt. works including election related works/business purposes.

This order shall be applicable under 45-Bhergaon LAC, 46-Udalguri (ST) LAC, 47-Mazbat LAC and 48-Tangla LAC of Udalguri District.

Due to urgent nature and as circumstances do not admit of the serving in due time of notice upon the person (public) against whom this order is directed hence it is passed ex-parte. Any person aggrieved with this order however is at liberty to appear before the court of the undersigned for appropriate consideration.

The Sr. Superintendent of Police, Udalguri shall enforce this order through Police Officers-in-Charge of all Police Stations, Police Out-Posts in Udalguri District.

This order shall remain effective from **5.00 PM of 7th April, 2026 till 5.00 PM of 10th April, 2026** within the concerned constituency/area or until completion of poll, whichever is applicable.

Any violation of this order is punishable U/S 223 BNS.
