PROHIBITORY ORDER
(U/S of 163 BNSS)

PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 163, BHARATIYA NAGARIK SURAKSHA SANHITA (BNSS) No.UDL/GELA/2026/11: WHEREAS, the issue of prohibitory order under section 163 BNSS is felt necessary with a view to maintain peace, security and tranquility of peaceful counting of votes in respect of General Election to Assam Legislative Assembly, 2026 which will be held on **04-05-2026** and to prevent any untoward incidents in Udalguri Election District during counting of votes.

I, **Jay Vikas, IAS, District Magistrate, Udalguri**, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under **Section 163 BNSS**, do hereby promulgate this prohibitory order banning the following in the interest of maintaining peace and tranquility in the Udalguri Election District area during the counting of votes for the General Election to Assam Legislative Assembly of 45-Bhergaon LAC, 46-Udalguri (ST) LAC, 47-Mazbat LAC and 48-Tangla LAC:

- 1) Procession and sloganeering of any kind within the premises of the Counting Centre till completion of counting of votes and declaration of result.
- 2) Use of PA system/loudspeaker and celebration of any political party or candidate within premises of the counting venue.
- 3) Temporary food stall and any other temporary shops within the radius of 100 metres from the counting centres.
- 4) Carrying sticks with or without flags, lathis, firearms, gathering of 5 or more person within radius of 1 KM from the counting centre.
- 5) Bursting of firecrackers and fireworks, during and after the counting on 04-05-2026.
- 6) Carrying mobile phones, cameras, electronic gadgets inside the counting hall (except those permitted by the authority).
- 7) Victory procession/rallies by any candidate/political party after declaration of results.

Considering the seriousness and urgency of the situation, this order has been passed ex-parte under section 163 BNSS and will remain in force until completion of the counting of votes.
Any violation of this order is punishable under section 223 BNS under the relevant provision of law.
